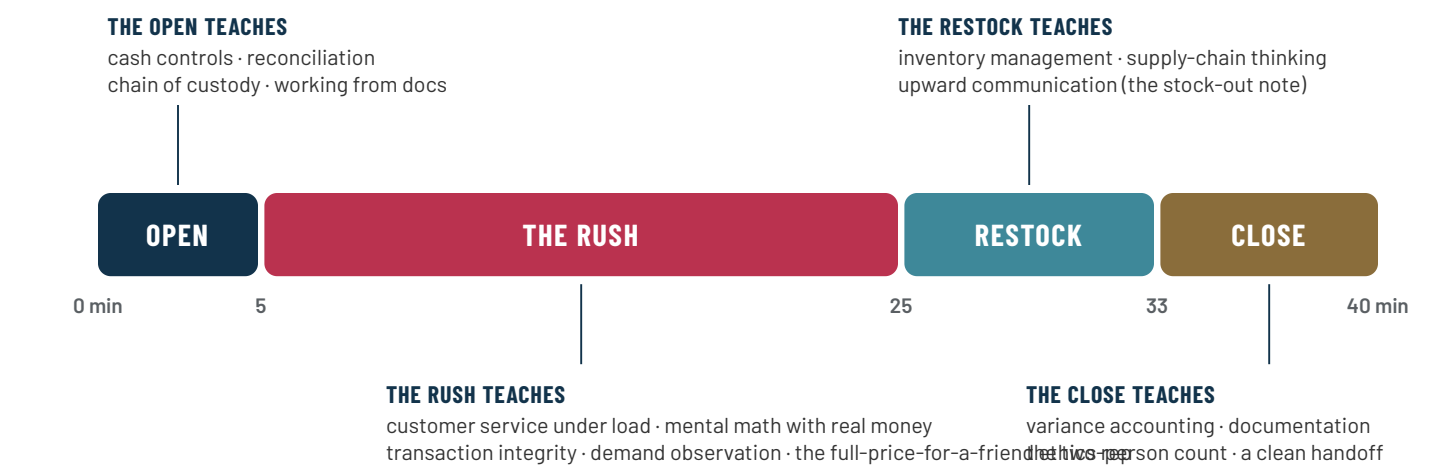


One ordinary 40-minute shift, mapped to what it teaches. Built to be handed to a skeptic.
